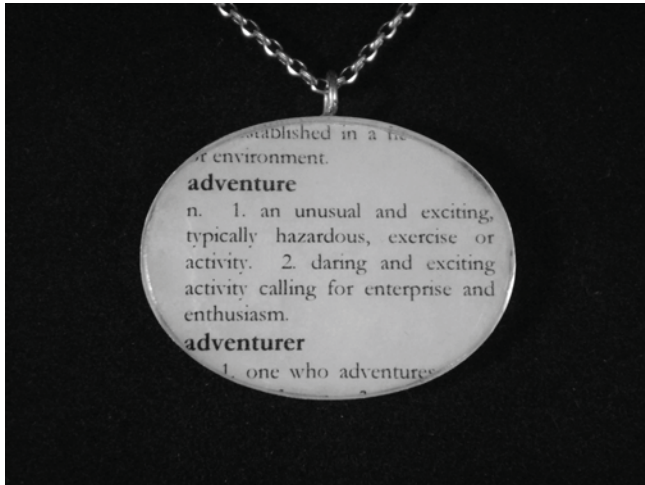


Large Pendants

Size of large pendant is 1 ¼ ” x 1 ½ ”.



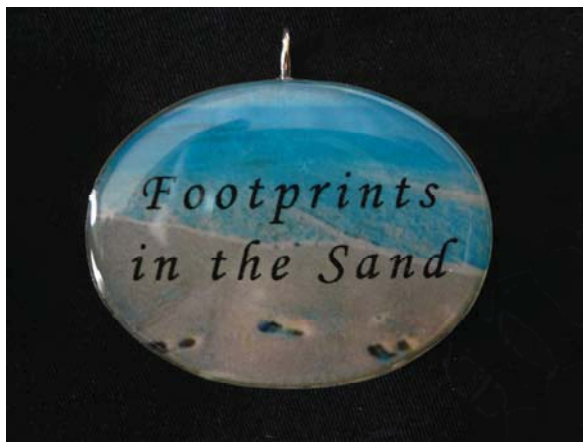

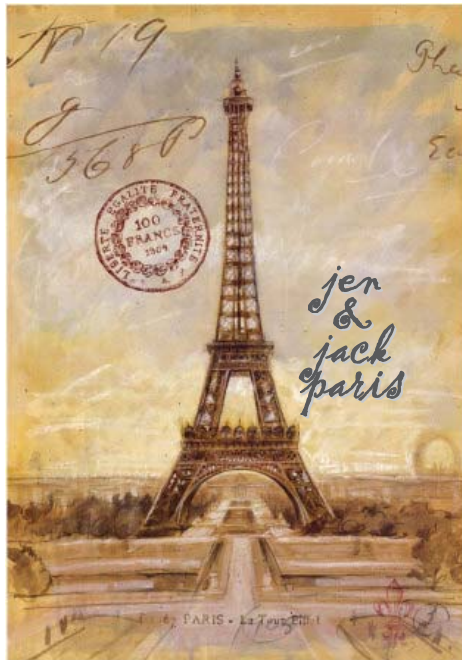

Large Pendants: Words with Definitions

adventure

n. 1. an unusual and exciting, typically hazardous, exercise or activity. 2. daring and exciting activity calling for enterprise and enthusiasm.

true

adj. 1. consistent with fact or reality; not false or erroneous. 2. reliable; accurate. 3. real; genuine. 4. faithful to a friend, vow or cause; steadfast; loyal.

zest

n. 1. added flavor or piquancy; 2. pure enjoyment; wholehearted interest; gusto; *the zest of life*.

panache (*french*)

n. 1. verve; flair; spirited self-assurance. 2. distinctive and stylish elegance of manner or sophistication. 3. an ornamental plume of feathers or tassels.

grace

n. 1. the simple elegance or refinement of movement. 2. courteous goodwill. 3. divine love and protection bestowed freely upon mankind.

trouble

1. adept at inspiring emotions of curiosity, strife, and confusion. 2. generally concerned with mischief, drama, and producing adequate levels of these emotions for amusement.

dream

n. 1. A series of images, ideas and emotions occurring in certain stages of sleep. 2. a daydream; reverie. 3. a wild fancy or hope. 4. an aspiration; ambition. 5. to imagine.

serendipity

n. 1. the faculty of making fortunate and unexpected discoveries by accident. 2. good fortune; luck

energy

n. 1. the strength and vitality required for sustained physical or mental activity. 2. vigor or intensity of expression.

marathon 26.2 miles

n. 1. any event of great duration requiring exceptional endurance. *There will be days I don't know if I can do a marathon. There will be a lifetime knowing that I have.*

journey

n. 1. travel from one place to another; trip. 2. something suggestive of passage or movement from one place to another: *the journey of life*.

friend

n. 1. a person whom one knows, likes and trusts. 2. a favored companion. 3. one with whom one is allied in a struggle or cause; comrade.

vitality

n. 1. exuberance, energy or vigor. 2. the capacity to live, grow or develop. 3. that which distinguishes the living; an energy, force or principle characteristic of life.

creativity

adj. 1. characterized by originality and expressiveness; imaginative. 2. having the ability to create things. 3. creating; productive.

fearless

adj. 1. without fear; bold or brave; intrepid. 2. calmly resolute in facing dangers or perils. 3. invulnerable to fear or intimidation.

princess

n. 1. a hereditary female ruler; queen. 2. the female ruler of a principality. 3. any woman thought of as having the status or qualities of a princess.

spirit

n. 1. the nonphysical part of a person that is the seat of emotion and character; the soul.

moxie

n. 1. courage and aggressive energy; initiative. 2. vigor; verve; pep. 3. the ability to face difficulty with spirit. 4. skill; know-how.

serenity

n. 1. the state or quality of being serene; dignity; tranquility. 2. clearness; brightness.

drama

n. 1. a prose or verse composition written for performance. 2. the quality or condition of being dramatic. 4. striking in appearance or forcefully effective.

balance

n. 1. even distribution of weight enabling someone or something to remain upright and steady. 2. stability of one's mind or feelings.

diva

n. 1. Italian, "goddess" from Latin, feminine *divus*. 2. a distinguished female operatic singer; prima donna.

sparkle

n. 1. to shine or glisten with little gleams of light, as a brilliant gem; glitter. 2. to effervesce, as wine. 3. to be brilliant, lively, or vivacious.

bliss

n. 1. perfect happiness; great joy. 2. something providing such happiness. 3. a state of spiritual blessedness.

character

n. 1. the combination of qualities or features that distinguishes one person, group or thing from another. 2. moral or ethical strength; integrity; fortitude. 3. a person who is unconventional.
